DOFFING (take off) PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT Coastall



Ensure you are at least 2 meters from patient before beginning







GLOVES

The outer surface may be contaminated.

- 1. Pinch the outer glove surface and remove the first glove; hold this in your gloved hand.
- 2. Slide fingers of ungloved hand under the other glove at the wrist.
- 3. Peel glove over wrist and discard.

HAND HYGIENE - Clean all surfaces of hands and wrists







GOWN

The outer surface may be contaminated.

- 1. Unfasten ties.
- 2. Cross your arms and pull the gown away from your neck and shoulders.
- 3. Turn the gown inside out and roll the gown into a bundle and discard in soiled linen cart (cloth) or regular waste (disposable).

HAND HYGIENE - Clean all surfaces of hands and wrists



EYE PROTECTION

The outer surface may be contaminated.

- 1. When removing goggles or face shield handle only the sides or elastic band.
- 2. Disposable discard in regular waste.
- Reusable set aside. Once doffing complete clean and disinfect from the inside out with wipe - allow 1 minute wet contact time - rinse with water - air dry.

HAND HYGIENE - Clean all surfaces of hands and wrists







MASK or RESPIRATOR

Doff N95 or elastomeric respirator outside room.

- 1. Remove ear loop or elastic from nape of neck.
- 2. Lean forward and gently remove the elastic from the crown of your head without disturbing the respirator or mask.
- 3. Disposable discard in waste container.
- 4. Elastomeric respirators are reusable follow OHS guidelines for care and use.

HAND HYGIENE - Clean all surfaces of hands and wrists
