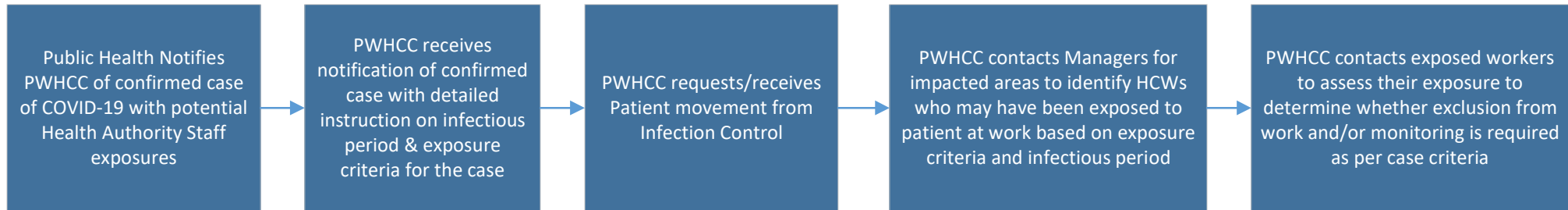


Healthcare Worker COVID-19 Exposures & Inquiries

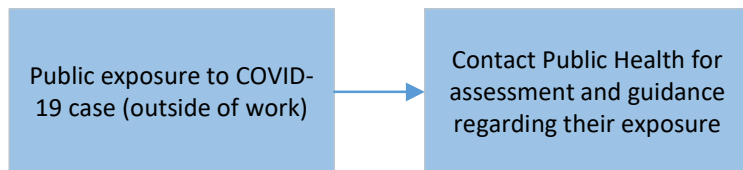


Process for Occupational Exposures to COVID-19 for Healthcare Workers employed by a Health Authority

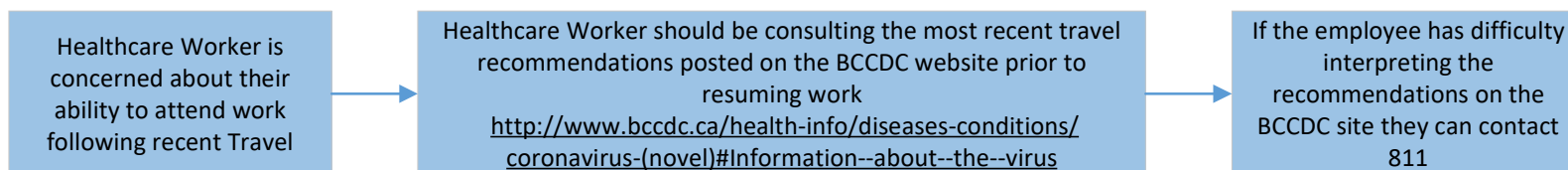


Staff who believe they have been exposed at work and have not heard from the Provincial Workplace Health Call Centre ***can assume the patient's test was negative and there is no COVID-19 exposure.*** Staff should continue working and practicing routine precautions and wearing appropriate PPE.

Process for Healthcare Workers who may have had an exposure to COVID-19 as a result of recent travel
