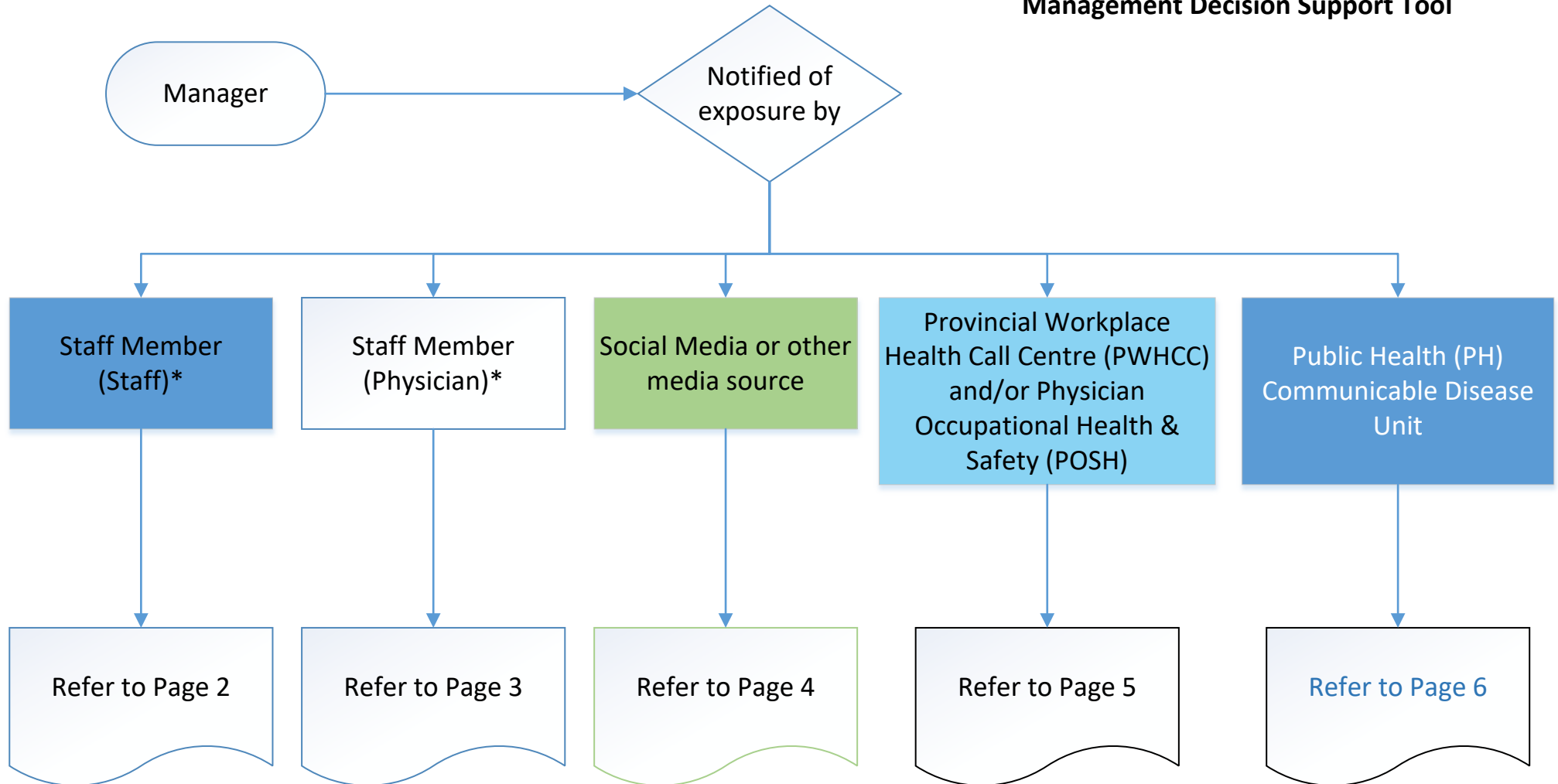
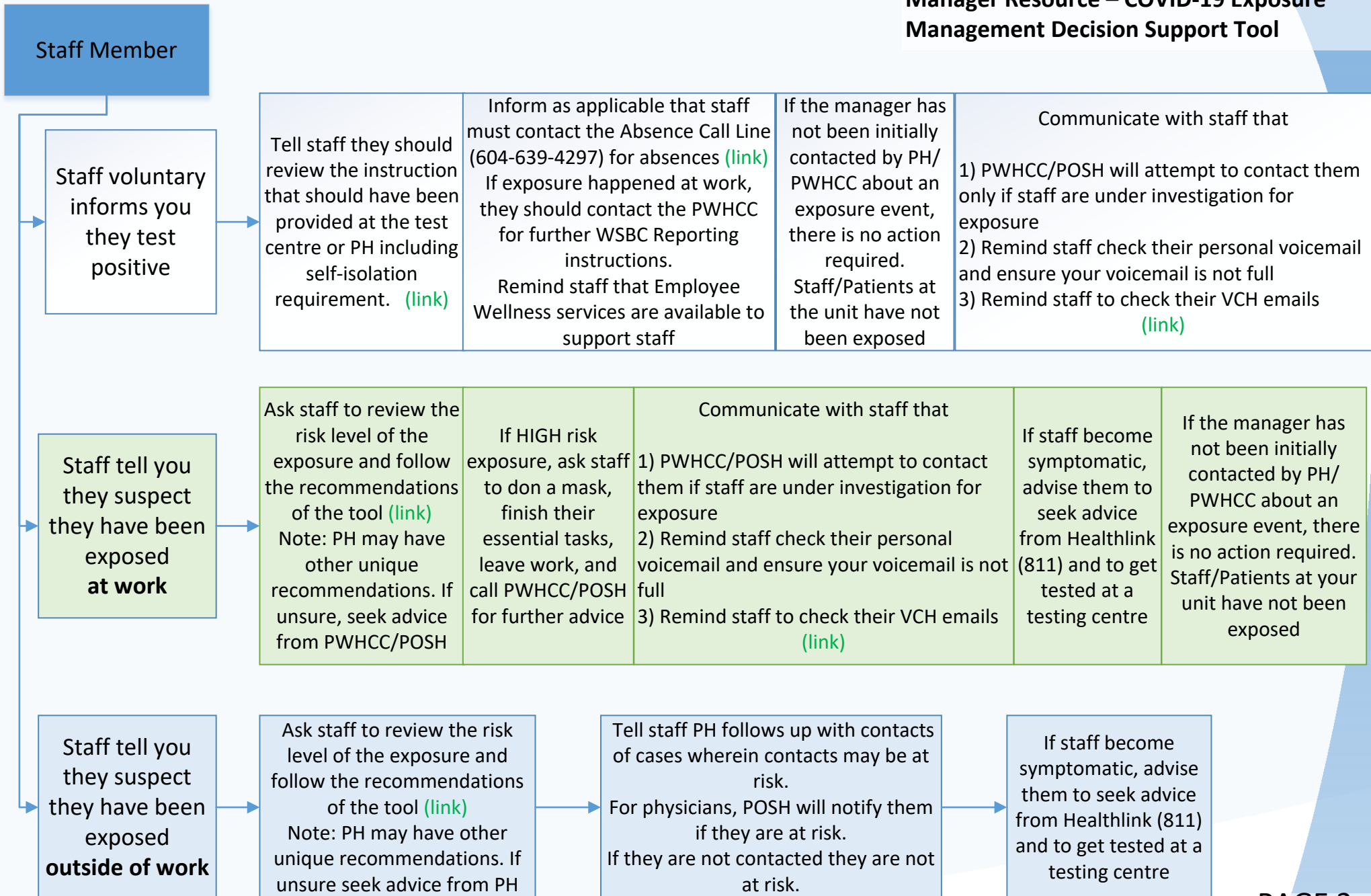


Manager Resource – COVID-19 Exposure Management Decision Support Tool



*Note: While staff or physicians may voluntarily inform managers of the exposure / lab result, managers must not ask or actively seek for diagnosis / results. Manager can however ask about work restrictions for operational and scheduling purposes.

POSH will help support PH to provide advice:

- If they are positive
- If they have been exposed
- If they suspect they have been exposed at work
- If they suspect they have been exposed not at work
- If their dependant is ill and is seeking direction regarding isolation

Social Media or other media source

If the manager has not been initially contacted by PH/PWHCC about an exposure event, there is no action required.

Staff/Patients at the unit have not been exposed

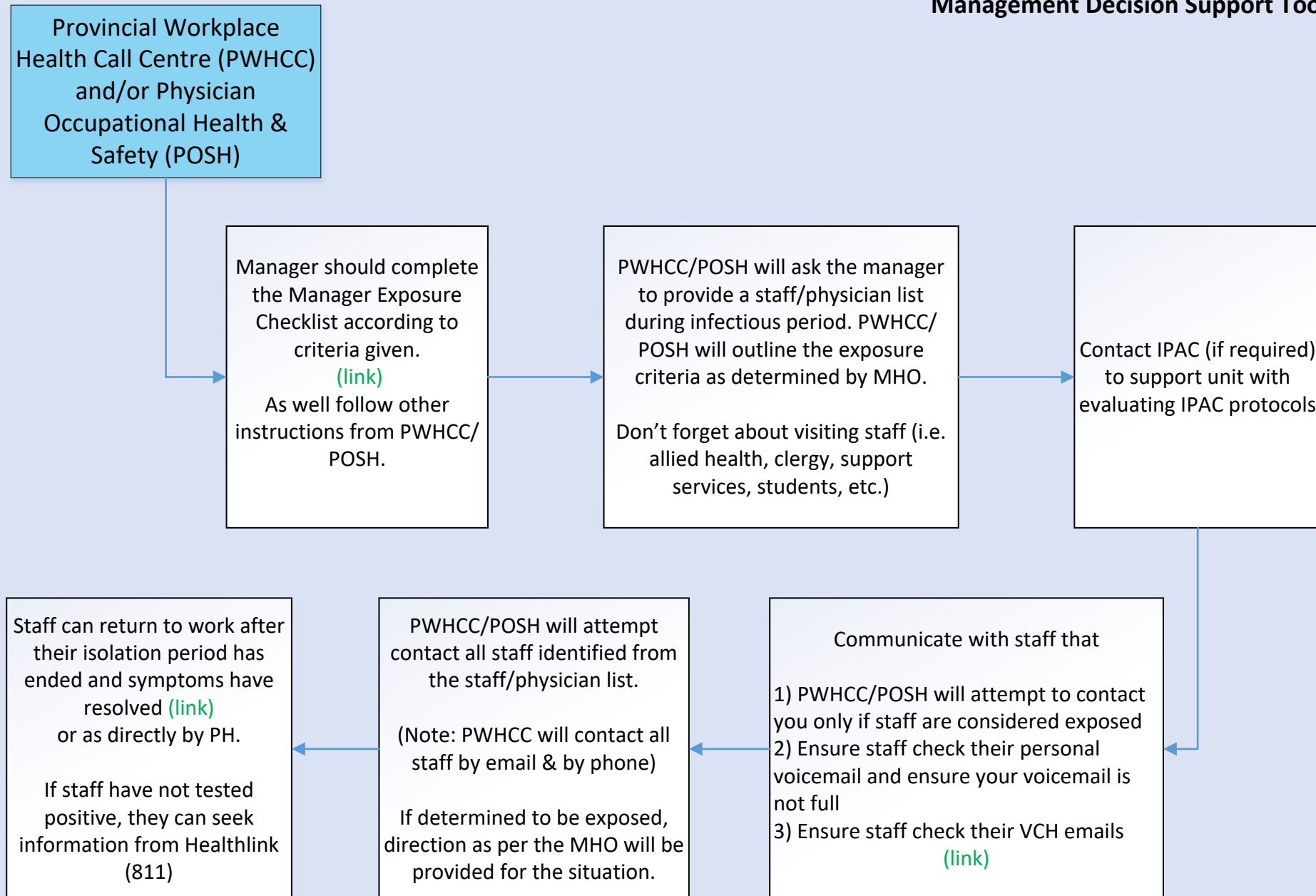
Communicate with any concerned staff that

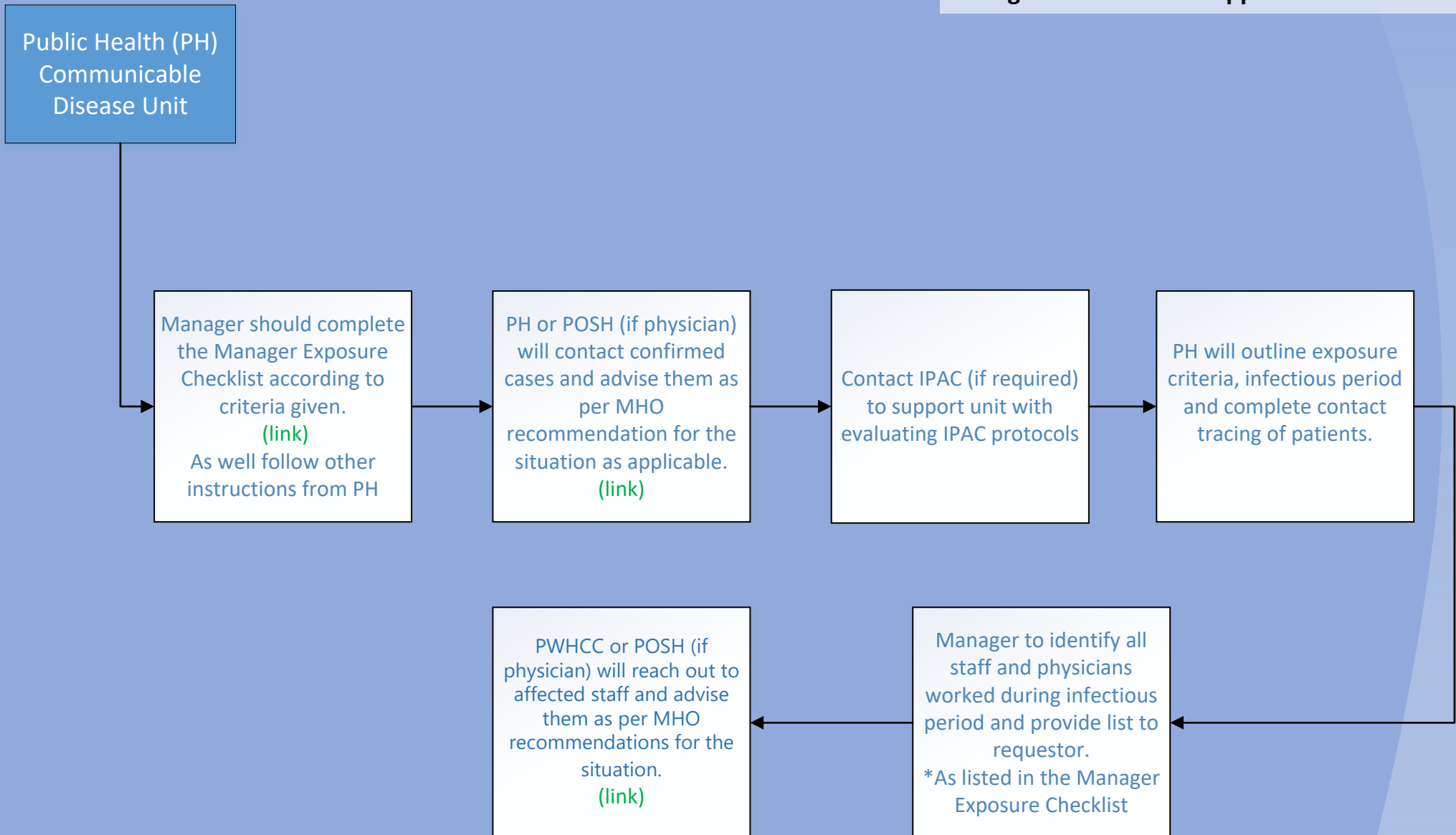
- 1) PWHCC/POSH/PH will attempt to contact you only if staff are under investigation
- 2) Ensure staff check their personal voicemail and ensure your voicemail is not full
- 3) Ensure staff check their VCH emails [\(link\)](#)

If staff become symptomatic, advise them to seek advice from Healthlink (811) and get tested at a testing centre

When attending the testing site, be sure to take and show EE ID and identify self as Health Care Worker
