

Point-of-Care Risk Assessment Do I need PPE?



Before ANY interaction with the patient/client or their environment:

Could my clothes or skin come in contact with body fluids, including splashes or sprays?

i.e. urine, soiled linen, blood



If yes, wear a gown








Could my hands come in contact with soiled surfaces, bodily fluids, non-intact skin, or mucous membranes?

Gloves do not replace hand hygiene









Could my eyes, face, or mucous membranes be splashed or sprayed with body fluids or will I be within 2 meters of a coughing or vomiting resident?

If yes, wear eye protection & mask





Clean your hands.

Practice good hand hygiene by cleaning your hands with alcohol based hand rub (ABHR) or soap and water .
