## **Wound Care Guidelines in Long-Term Care**

Store wound supplies in a closed area in or in a lockable wound cart like the medication cart  Wound dressing product from no touch technique/clean technique	<ul> <li>Stock minimal supplies.</li> <li>Wound cart shall stay outside the resident room.</li> <li>Cover care plan in a plastic cover when taking into the residents' room.</li> <li>Bring only the required dressing supplies into the room.</li> <li>Containers should not be used to hold supplies going into residents' rooms.</li> <li>All extra or unused supplies are to be throw it on the garbage.         Nothing from a resident's room can go back in the wound cart or supply room.         Dedicate wound cleansing solutions and wound care product.     </li> <li>See Prevention of Wound Infection —Saving Dressing Pieces, When to Use &amp; How to Save</li> <li>Save in a sterile container or resealable bag.</li> <li>Saved dressing(s) pieces are only kept for 2 weeks; after that time discard the container or bag and any remaining dressing pieces.</li> <li>Label name and date with name label, date open and expiry date</li> <li>Store all used supplies in the resident room in a covered box that is labeled with the resident name.</li> </ul>
Cleansing solution	Normal saline:  • Discard dedicated Normal Saline after 24 hours,
	<ul> <li>Name, label and date normal saline bottles used for wound care.</li> <li>For specialized solutions, follow manufacturers instructions.</li> <li>See <u>Product information sheets</u></li> </ul>
Treatment Wound Binder	Kept on the top Wound Dressing Cart  Each resident with skin & wound should have a treatment sheet.  Each resident to have an updated treatment sheet.
