
Viral Respiratory Illness (VRI) Case Communication Community

VRI Case Definition:

Fever or new/worsening cough <u>and</u> one of the following symptoms:

- Chills, shortness of breath
- Runny or stuffy nose
- · Sore throat, hoarseness, difficulty swallowing
- Swollen or tender glands in the neck
- Loss of taste or smell
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Severe weakness or fatigue
