BIOMEDICAL WASTE SEGREGATION

NON-ANATOMICAL WASTE Sterilization/Autoclave

Any items saturated with, dripping with, or containing blood or body fluids.

- Some saturated or dripping items:
 - Pads
 - Sponges
- Bandages
- Gauze
- Some items containing blood/ body fluids:
- IV bags and tubing
- Suction liners
- Fluid drainage containers
- Pleurevac and Hemovac units
- Plastic tubing

DO NOT Include

- ▶ Hair, teeth, nails
- Diapers, urine or feces, unless visibly contaminated with blood

CONTAINER



SHARPS WASTE

Sterilization/Autoclave

Items capable of cutting or puncturing the skin and that have come into contact with blood, body fluids or microorganisms.

- All needles and devices containing needles or spikes
- Broken medical glassware
- Contaminated scalpel blades, scissors, razors
- Lancets
- **Full sharps containers**

DO NOT Include

Cytotoxic Sharps

ANATOMICAL WASTE Incineration

Human tissue, organs, and body parts.

- Human tissue
- Body parts

DO NOT Include

Hair, teeth and nails (dispose of in garbage container)



Waste that has come into contact with Cytotoxic agents.

- IV bags and tubing
- Urine bags and diapers
- Gloves and masks
- Pads, sponges, bandages and gauze
- Disposable surgical gowns and drapes
- Nominally empty vials, ampoules and syringes

DO NOT Include

Any unused or partially used Cytotoxic drugs. These should be treated as Cytotoxic **Pharmaceutical Waste**







CYTOTOXIC SHARPS NEED TO BE PLACED INTO A COMPLIANT RED SHARPS CONTAINER







Items NOT saturated with, dripping with, or containing blood or body fluids.

- Empty IV bags and tubing
- Uncontaminated gloves and masks
- General isolation room waste
- Soiled dressings, pads, sponges and gauze
- **Feminine hygiene products**
- ► Diapers, urine, feces
- Empty medical waste containers
- Disposable surgical gowns and drapes
- ▶ Teeth, hair, nails
- ► Syringes without needles
- Catheters
- Coffee cups
